

Seven Pro Photos - just a short reminder for models...

Be on time.

Coming late to your appointment does not only distract you, also the photographer, the make-up artist and other are on time waiting for you.

Be prepared

Have your clothing (dress, shoes, etc.) prepared in a bag or small suitcase without wrinkles if possible.

Prepare yourself

Learn how to do your makeup (as we do not have a make-up artist on the set every time), keep a comb or brush in your "toolbox", keep your fingernails clean and manicured (if necessary), have lotion for your face and hands.

Make yourself comfortable

Arriving on the set on time try to make yourself familiar with the environment and make yourself comfortable. Have a seat, get yourself something to drink, coffee, water or a snack. Feeling well is essential for good photos. Place your bag or other items at the change area, check your clothing. Have a chat with others on the set. No worries as we are all humans ;-)

For outdoor shootings:

Keep yourself warm or cool (warm jacket, shoes, gloves, heat bags or sunhat, sun blocker, sun glasses, etc.). Don't care how you look like staying warm or sun protected – feeling comfortable at the set is most important.

Lingerie shooting, etc.:

wear comfortable, wide clothes without underwear (if possible) as dents (e.g. from bra straps or socks) are highly visible and mostly not retouch able on the photos.

Most important: talk to the crew (e.g. photographer) if you are unwell or feel not comfortable.

Only if you are feeling good, the photos will be good!
